Further to the interview of our London Agent
(Mr. W. Simmons) with one of your Officials, we beg to confirm
the transaction he then laid before you.

These 400 bundles of Galvanized Corrugated Sheets
were part of a Contract made with a German Firm (Messrs.
Coutinho, Carr & Co of Hamburg) and were in transit to Mombasa
British East Africa when War broke out. The London branch of
Messrs. Coutinho & Co; being unable to remit the value of the
said sheets agreed to give up their title to this particular
parcel conditionally that we would pay the Freight, and obtain
payment from their customers (Messrs. Wm O'Gswald & Co of Mombasa)
on arrival of the goods. All the employees of Messrs. Wm O'Gswald
& Co, however having been interned and the activities of the firm
brought to a standstill, the goods have been lying in charge
of the Customs Authorities and have incurred (so we are advised
by the Steamers Agents in Mombasa, Messrs. The East African
Trading Co) charges amounting to between £250 and £300 in
addition to a 10% duty on the value of the Iron, which has to
be paid before their release can be obtained.

We respectfully beg to point out that we have already suffered considerable loss on this transaction, owing to high cost of Cabling, freight etc. and we desire your intervention on our behalf to obtain if possible a withdrawal of the aforementioned Customs charges in Mombasa. Indeed so heavy has our loss been already that we have been compelled to transfer to Messrs Boustead Bros, London (without any payment from them until sold) our interest in the goods in order that they may dispose of them where they lie at practically any price obtainable.

If therefore you will be good enough to act for us and take the matter up with the Mombasa Authorities to ^{waive} these charges under these very exceptional circumstances, we shall feel very grateful.

The total approximate value of the consignment is £3000 particulars of which you will find on the enclosed copies of Invoices.

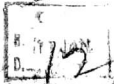
