The Belgian Colonial Office have sent a
Note from Mons. Reulin as the name acting
that we should transmit following information to
you in reference to two live motor boats
brought in number by General Henry, which
has to be at the head of BEA Corporation to
transport to Lake Edward.

1. Are the two motor boats now en route to
Lake Edward? the Agent is now registered
by Commissioner Montale?
2. The BEA Corporation is to forward
urgently to Lake Edward a transport

Supply of petrol, kerosine, and lubricating oils for these boats, estimating ^{locally} quantity to send.

3. Corporation Spare parts for motor boats carried for by General Henry per Corporation go out S/S Matiana

4. Can Corporation state how far the boats (which left Dukakata on Aug 30th for Butcher) have got on the journey, and can Mons. Reulin rely on their reaching Butcher by 1st October and in good working condition -

The Addressee goes on to state that on the reply to question 1 + 4 depends his decision whether to send one from Home another motor boat as per a requisition received by him from General Henry but dated anterior to his letter perchance to the 2 boats already here. They say this matter is urgent as concerned with their proposed "motor boat armament" at Lake Edward. — P. S. among others said.

PARAPHRASE

TELEGRAM. The Secretary of State for the Colonies
to the Governor of the East Africa
Protectorate.

(Sent 12.0 p.m. 25th September, 1915.)

25th of September. Following message from
British East Africa Corporation in London for the
Corporation, Mombasa regarding 2 motor boats for Lake
Edward which have been bought by General Henry at
Mombasa, (begins)

1. Are the two motor boats now en route for Lake Edward the same as those inspected by Commandant Klaert?
2. The Corporation at Mombasa is to forward urgently to Lake Edward three months' supply of kerosine, petrol, and lubricating oils for these boats, estimating locally what quantity to send.
3. The spare parts for motor boats for which General Henry telegraphed through Corporation are being sent out in S.S. "Africa".
4. Can the Corporation state how far the boats now en route have got on the journey and can the Belgian Government rely on their reaching Rutshuru in good working condition by October 1st? (Ends).
