the raising of the squadron
which can without
inconvenience be charged
debited at once against
the Protectorate Govt they
should be so debited.

4. Mr Brown has also not
apprehend that the
recommendation of the G. O. C.
that the cost of the
additional squadron
should be debited to Comms
Chgo's extends to the pay
of the ~~squadron~~ ^{chick}, so
far as he is aware, is
a protective charge
entirely with the pay
of the rest of the E. A.
Mounted Rifles.

Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No. 771 of the 21st of October on the subject of the cost of raising, mounting, and remounting, an additional squadron of the East Africa Mounted Rifles.

2. I am informed by the General Officer Commanding that all accounts have been regarded as common stock and issued from depôts to units as required, whether such units belong to the Indian Expeditionary Force, Common Organizations, or Protectorate troops. He is therefore of opinion that the cost of the additional squadron should be debited to Common Charges and subsequently adjusted on the lines suggested in regard to the issue of Ordnance and Supply stores and equipment, referred to
