The Deputy of the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies
(Received Colonial Office 3.55 p.m. 19th February, 1916)

With reference to my telegram 17th February No: 41 following telegram has been received from Kismayu to-day (Begins) February 17th Italian Resident Guimbo reports Goshu village, North of Jelba burnt down by Aulihan also villages on Italian side. Italian station Bidi has been closed Resident and Askaris at Bidi have been transferred to Jelba Italian troops have been sent to Italian stations on the river. Italians state that situation has become serious. Am sending fifty troops from Yonta to Alexandra after consultation with Officer Commanding the Troops Jubaland ^{troops} Kismayu urgently required (Ends.) General Officer Commanding has arranged to send Arab rifles consisting of five British Officers one Native Officer and 202 rank and file under the command of Mure Assistant District Commissioner to Kismayu.

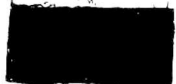
