Mr. B. Williams

In his report in 5915/15 Mr. B. Williams said: "Until actual experiments are made, it is what supply can be had, the outflow of Kibuye is a matter of opinion, and is a matter of opinion only. At present we know that the present supply is insufficient. In my opinion I can only reiterate that I consider the present water supply insufficient for the wants of the future." This does not give the impression that Mr. B. Williams knew what he was talking about; Mr. J. J. Simpson was actually present but in reply that the outflow of Kibuye was a matter of opinion, but one of fact. Mr. B. Williams had changed his mind that after 3 1/2 months dry weather it was producing just under 1,000,000 gallons a day.
