The composition, originally 3/4, is now 1/2. Evidently there is a greater tendency to demand cash for the notes, but on my recollection the Govt view that the tendency is probably only temporary and that there is no need, by selling securities (as done at a considerable loss) to reduce the invested portion of the fund.

the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office 1.43 a.m. 13th May, 1916)

145 Unusual circumstances have made it
advisable to increase the coin portion of the Currency
Note Guarantee Fund by 5 lakhs of rupees. It will be
necessary to import this from India and it can be
conveniently arranged through the National Bank of
India who will require repayment to be made in Bombay.
As these circumstances will not continue necessarily
indefinitely sanction requested to meet this by an
advance from Protectorate surplus balances which are
at present estimated at over £270,000 pending further
instructions from you on full report which follows.
If you approve please inform me by telegraph and ask
War Office to advance this sum to set free part of
the Protectorate surplus balances which are being
utilised to defray war expenses and arrange repayment
to Bank in Bombay.


