(i) On the 23rd a letter dated Marsabit July 30th was received from Mr. Kittermaster. Mr. Butler has reported all quiet on the frontier and has received a message from Ali Abdi, headman of the Garreh, to say that his tribes has been successful in driving their enemies the Dagodia out of the Country across the Daua river and is now ready to assist the Government against the Aulihan, who are said to be divided, the Tur Adi being with the Bartiri on the Juba river, the Wafattu under Abdurrahman Mursaal near Wanti 3 hours north east of Eil Wak and the Rer Afgab under Gabobi two or three days from Wajheir.

Mr. Glenday reports that he has been down to Deila, about half way between Buna and Wajheir to the east of the Moyale road and found every thing quiet. Mr. Kittermaster has instructed him to take active measures against Wajheir Dagodia if he found them becoming difficult.

N.B. The information in the first of the above paras. corresponds sufficiently closely with that received from Jubaland, vide I.(ii) of Precis for week ending August 19th.

(ii) On the same day a letter dated Wajheir July 16th was received through the Commissioner of Police from Major Rigby. He reports that Wajheir was re-occupied on July 15th with 1½ Companies, East Africa Police, Machine Gun, and 36 Mounted Infantry. The column marched 76 miles in 3 days over waterless country, only six men falling out.

Major Rigby is informed that the Rer Afgab are west of Ribba some 30 miles distant and he proposes, as soon as the further ½ Company arrives, to move out against them.

(iii) No news was received from Jubaland during the week.
