Dear Bottomley,

With reference to Corcoran's letter to you 0165/7528 (F.2.) of 14th May last, about charge pay for Lieutenant Colonel Sturdy in East Africa.

On reading over our letter of 20th May to General Smuts, (copy sent to you by Corcoran on 22nd inst), I think that possibly it may not have been made clear to the local authorities that the pay should be charged to the common charges account which is financed out of Army Funds. Do you see any objection to our now so informing General Smuts? This will be in agreement with what seems to have been done locally in regard to the extra emoluments given to Lieutenant McClymont who also is a Protectorate official in the Veterinary service - see your note of 18th May to Corcoran.

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your Confidential Despatch of the 7th of June and in accordance with the request contained in paragraph 2 to transmit herewith a return showing those Protectorate civil officials employed with the military forces who are drawing pay additional to their civil emoluments.

2. I have invariably stipulated that an officer of the civil establishment, seconded for service with the military authorities, should not suffer pecuniary deprivation by such secondment, that is to say, they should continue to draw their civil rate of pay together with any duty allowance. Emoluments granted to them while in military service in addition

addition to such pay are settled by the military authorities, and I can only presume that they are granted after due consideration of the merits in each case. I see no reason, for instance, why an Assistant District Commissioner who is seconded to the military and is performing the duties of an officer of the rank of Major should not receive additional pay commensurate with his added responsibilities.

3. I will inform you later if any officers of the Uganda Railway are similarly affected.
