Statement

MEMORANDUM

In forwarding attached papers I beg to say that the courage and sense of duty shown by many of the men included in the list, deserves the highest praise. They kept the traffic going on the Railway at a time when bombings were of frequent occurrence and the defence of the Railway received scant attention. Individual mention of all those concerned would unduly swell the list, but the intrepid behaviour shown by the running staff in the danger zone deserves recognition. The period was April 1915 to January 1916. I do not think that General Tiche drew attention to the matter in his despatches.
