With reference to your letter of the 18th ultimo, respecting the facilities which it is desired shall be accorded to Mr. Christian Thoms during his projected journey in East and South Africa, I have the honour to inform you that enquiries of the Belgian Government show that Mr. Thoms ceased to be Belgian Consul General for Norway some two years ago.

In the present condition of affairs in Africa, I regret to have to inform you that His Majesty's Government are reluctant to give any facilities for travelling to that continent.
