I am commanded by the Army Council to acknowledge the receipt of your letter 15008 of 31<sup>st</sup> March, enclosing a copy of a despatch to the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate on the subject of the remuneration of the Administrative officials who have been detached for duty as Political Officers with the forces operating against German East Africa.

As regards paragraph 2 of your letter, I am to state that the Council had no intention of suggesting that Protectorate funds should bear any charges for travelling or rations in respect of these officials while they are not engaged on Protectorate business.
