Sir,

I am commanded by the Army Council to acknowledge the receipt of your letter No. 2127/1916 dated the 10th May 1916 forwarding a copy of telegraphic correspondence with the Governor of the East African Protectorate on the subject of the distribution of copies of the regarding Islam captured by General Smith at Mesh.

I am to say that photographic copies of the original and the certificate as to its genuineness together with a translation of the document in various languages in pamphlet form are being prepared under the direction of the General Officer Commanding in Egypt for distribution, and that he has been instructed to supply direct to the Colonial Administrations indicated in the list enclosed with the Colonial Office note of May 8th, the number of copies therein mentioned, and in addition to send 200 copies to the Secretary of State for the Colonies for use and record in London.
