## OPERATIONS

*From Lieut. Colonel Sauts to Chief of the Imperial General Staff.*

(No. F. 5294)

21st June 1916 10.30 pm

The leading column of our troops met a strong force of the enemy yesterday during the attack from Harrison. The enemy held carefully close and prepared positions in dense bush and most of engagement resulted in which we lost 18 killed and about 70 wounded, of which only two were seriously wounded. Most of our casualties were in the 4th South African Infantry. The enemy must also have suffered severely and he retired after the action but he proceeded to occupy the position today.
