22nd June. My earlier telegram of 7th June. Following telegram has been received from Barrett begins. Chase has temporarily been unable by my arrival here. The Nile River is falling. Delay is causing bad effect. Time for a rapid and decisive blow quickly passing. There are no Aulihan near Serenli can occupy from here without opposition. ends. Barrett is believed to be at Garfashere still but above telegram was sent from Lugh.
