(Despatched Colonial Office 7.00 p.m. 22nd June, 1917.)

22nd June. By cipher telegram of 7th June. Following telegram has been received from Barrett begins. This has temporarily been ~~supplied~~ by arrival here. The River is falling. Delay is causing bad effect. Time for a rapid and decisive blow quickly passing. There are no auxiliaries near Serenli can occupy from here without opposition. ends. Barrett is believed to be at Gargechare still but above telegram was sent from Lugh.
