The position of the Garribh country is shown on the map below.

The Garreh are bounded up the East by the Marshan and on the North by the Dagodia tribes. As the despatch clearly shows, they have in the past suffered severely from the attacks of both these tribes and the Government have been unable to give them much assistance. They are a peaceful and loyal tribe, and it is therefore most desirable that they should receive all possible support from the Government.

The present situation is that the Dugdila are quiescent after a severe defeat inflicted on them by Mr. Glenday at RAMU, while the presence of Colonel Barrett's patrol in the Marchau country prevents that tribe from attacking the Garreh. The position is therefore comparatively satisfactory, though precarious.
