318. 12th June.

It is stated that there will be total eclipse moon 4th July would be grateful if I could be informed to what extent it will be visible here as I consider desirable that steps should be taken to prevent it from being regarded with any undue significance by superstitious native tribes and to counteract mischievous propaganda which may be circulated by the enemy. You may consider desirable to warn other Colonial Governments take similar action.
