

With reference to your confidential despatch of the 25th August 1916, on the subject of irregularities in connection with Military Expenditure, I have the honour to ask for your authority to write off the sum of Rs. 450, being the amount of two months salary inadvertently paid twice to an Intelligence Agent named Lashoo for the months of October and November 1914.

2. This man left the country in April 1916, and cannot now be traced.

3. From enquiries made I am satisfied that the overpayment occurred at a time when the Pay Department was much understaffed and overworked
