I submit the draft of a letter for Miss Page to send to the Archbishop's Chaplain. I think we had better give him all the information in the telegram except the last sentence. It might look a little disingenuous if we stopped short at the end of the first sentence and the Archbishop afterwards heard that certain missionaries had been called up. The missions named in the last sentence of the telegram were, as you know, under suspicion by the military authorities, and I have no doubt that the local Government have thought this the best way of dealing with them.


