It might look a little disingenuous if we stopped short at the end of the first sentence and the Archbishop afterwards heard that certain missionaries had been called up. The missions named in the last sentence of the telegram were, as you know, under suspicion by the military authorities, and I have no doubt that the local Government have thought this the best way of dealing with them.

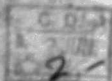

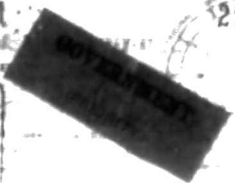
