
Here is a comprehensive historical survey of the sexual life and ideas of the Romans, the first book of its kind to appear in English. In view of the popular but erroneous belief that ancient Rome was inclined either to fantastic orgies or to the strictest asceticism, a coherent description of Roman sex life is particularly interesting. Attention is paid to that cruelty which seems to be an essential feature of the Roman character, and which, as sadism, is now recognized as having a sexual basis. 



















ROUGH SKETCH MAP OF



Boundaries of Uganda & E.A.P.




Bough Sketch to illustrate proposed alteration in




Rough Sketch to illustrate

19. In February 1917, His Excellency Dr. G. E. Jackson,  
Deputy with Provincial Commissioner, Amur, and Sir  
Frederick Jackson adopted Sir Frederick Jackson's line along  
the border of the Chatorongi hills as far as River Kanyon-  
Kanyon, Kanyon continuing eastwards. His Excellency's  
proposed boundary is marked in red ink, 1.

The above proposal was submitted to Dr. Jackson but no  
definitive reply thereto has been received.

20. There were then five different suggestions for  
boundary (all included in Map 46). No definite decision  
had been arrived at with respect to these five suggestions  
when H. J. Spiers proceeded to Kachelliba and proposed the  
question to Mr. Cawson. The joint recommendation  
submitted by H. J. Spiers and Cawson are practically  
identical and Sir Frederick Jackson's proposal referred  
to in paragraph 18. The recommendations in detail are given  
in enclosure 3 to (118a) p. 1.

The proposed boundary is not marked on any map, but it  
would appear that his purpose is that, excepting N. Zanyangara  
near the M. - M. Manyangara, with the exception of a  
small triangle in the neighbourhood of N. Kanyon, Sir  
Frederick Jackson's line has been recommended.  
This proposed line places Kachelliba in Uganda.

The joint recommendation is the subject of (118) from  
Uganda and has, as yet, received no reply from His  
Excellency.
