Sir,


2. In the course of timber felling operations a tree fell on, and severely crushed, this man's leg, necessitating amputation, but a careful enquiry into the incident has failed to reveal any remissness of supervision on the part of the Foreman in charge.

3. I propose to cause this compensation to be paid in monthly instalments of Rs.5 which will be charged to the "Pensions and Gratuities Vote", and trust that you will accord my action your approval.
