Sir,

I have the honour to report that subject to your approval I have sanctioned the payment of Rs.150 to a native Public Works Department labourer as compensation for an injury sustained by him in the performance of his duties.

2. In the course of timber felling operations a tree fell on, and severely crushed, this man's leg, necessitating amputation, but a careful enquiry into the incident has failed to reveal any remissness of supervision on the part of the Foreman in charge.

3. I propose to cause this compensation to be paid in monthly instalments of Rs.5 which will be charged to the "Pensions and Gratuities Vote", and trust that you will accord my action your approval.
