I am directed by Mr. Secretary Harcourt to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th of November, and to inform you that in cases where the general public have subscribed or where individuals have made gifts to Colonial Troops on active service Mr. Harcourt would be prepared to invite Colonial Governments to admit such gifts free of duty.
