With reference to your letter ²⁸⁹⁰62005/1916 of the 8th instant, I am directed by Mr. Secretary Balfour to say, for the information of Mr. Secretary Long, that the name of Messrs. Klatzer & Company now appears in Class "A" of the General Black List, and is under consideration for inclusion in the Statutory List.

Until their name is actually published in the Statutory List, the policy of this Department as regards the shipment of goods from them to the United Kingdom or British Empire, is to warn firms in this country to have no fresh dealings with them, but to say that no objection is in general taken to the completion of contracts already in existence, unless these extend over a considerable period.
