I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th instant for which I am obliged. I note that you are consulting the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate on the matter, by despatch.

In a letter dated the 3rd day of November last Mr. Morrison informs us that he has been informed by the Acting General Manager that as soon as sanction had been received he was prepared to sign the draft Agreement. We think, therefore, there is no doubt that this draft agreement will contain all the terms of the arrangement. In the meantime we have paid the receipt for the £6,000 into the Bank.
