Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 21375/1917 dated 1st instant regarding Lance Corporal C.K.Hilton, East African Mounted Rifles, I am commanded by the Army Council to inform you that if this man had been serving in the British Army he would have been awarded a pension of:-

*No children
see 30153/17*

12/6d a week for six months conditional from the day after the date of discharge. He would also have been granted an additional allowance of 1/6d a week for each child under the age of 16 years.

Shortly before the expiration of the conditional period he would again be examined by a Medical Board and his claim to further pension considered.

I am to request that you will be so good as to return the proceedings of the Medical Board forwarded to you on the 13th ultimo, to enable a reply to be furnished as to whether Hilton's discharge would have been sanctioned had he been serving in the British Army.
