With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo (No. 8437/1917) I am directed by the Postmaster General to state, for the information of the Secretary of State for the Colonies, that he can recommend Mr. Bertram Lewis, a Second Division Clerk in the Accountant General's Department of the Post Office, for the appointment of Assistant Chief Accountant at Nairobi, in place of Mr. Fowler who has declined.

Mr. Lewis is 28 years of age, ~~and~~ has had 6 years' experience of accounting duties and is considered to be well fitted for the post. He was discharged from the Army on the 20th August 1914 on account of tonsillitis but he states that he has no recurrence of this ailment since his return to civil duties.
