PARAPHRASE TELEGRAM: From the Secretary of State for the
Colonies to the Governor General of the Union of
South Africa.

(Sent 10.30 a.m. 23rd November 1917)

I have received following telegram from
General Officer Commanding South Africa (begins)
9603 Captain J.E.Rhodes of the East Africa Medical
Service morphia mania on the recommendation of
Medical Board permanently unfit for service
domiciled in Johannesburg can I carry out discharge
here (ends). Inform General Officer Commanding that
provided that this Officer is not being tried by
court martial, and I presume this is not the case,
I approve ~~of~~ his arranging for relinquishment
of Commission. Action taken should be reported by
General Officer Commanding to Governor East Africa
Protectorate.
