We trust you will agree that this last mentioned document clearly sets out the fact that it will be a practical impossibility for us to comply with the requirement in the Bond, that the Certificate of landing for pargoes which are consigned to ourselves from Mombasa shall be produced to the customs Authorities in Mombasa within three months from the date of exportation of the consignments, and we shall esteem it a favour if you can see your way to suggest to the East African Government that the terms of the Bond be modified as regards this condition. Perhaps You may even kindly see your way to make such a suggestion by cable, for we have found that when such documents are required by the Bast African authorities by some given date, such as three months from date of ship sailing, our Mombasa House is often required to eable asking us to reply by wire why the document in question has not reached them. The local authorities are certainly always agreeable thin to extend the period re

the specific instance, but each such instance is a source of quite heavy cable expense to us, and no doubt similarly to other shippers.
