

Sir,

I have the honour to report that, with the advice of the Executive Council, I have ordered the deportation to Kisimayu of ex-Headman Muiruri wa Njema of the Kikuyu District, Ukamba Province, under the provisions of the Removal of Natives Ordinance 1909.

2. This man was convicted on the 11th June 1918 by the Resident Magistrate, Nairobi, of the offence of assaulting an European, and was sentenced to twelve lashes and was recommended to be deported.

3. I approved of this recommendation and in view of sworn evidence filed by the Acting Provincial Commissioner, Ukamba Province, and the District Commissioner, Kyambu, to the effect that Muiruri is often
