

Reports received from Turkana land during the past fortnight are not such as to warrant the usual summary.

The Abyssinians reported on the Nakhalale river, via penultimate paragraph of the last summary, are now said to have numbered twenty and to have been engaged in collecting her tax and not in selling rifles.

Major Rayne is expected in Nairobi in a few days time, when a conference on the Turkana situation will take place.
