

With reference to your letter of the 13th April (No. 17529:18) relative to the payment of compensation to the dependants of certain native members of the crew of the Steamers "Persia" and "Maloja," I am directed by the Board of Trade to state, for the information of Mr. Secretary Long, that an award of 72 Rupees per annum, to commence from the 31st December, 1915, has been made to the mother of Ali bin Mahomed.
