Forces and of the Nyasaland Field Force, and to request you to inform the L.C. of the Treasury that the ers in question will receive exactly the same gratuity as if they had been serving in the British Army, i.e. that the calculation will have regard to British Regimental rates of pay, allowances etc. etc. speing excluded.
