We have not been told the date of Miss Stewart's embarkation from EA: possibly this tot. means that it was 3 Feb. If so, she put in 41 months' service. We do not know where all this service was performed but H. M. B. report - 28682 shows that part of it at any rate was in SEA: if it was all there this would give her ¹²³ 42 1/2 days' vacation leave, of which she has had 3 months in S Africa. As she has arrived here 24 April she has exceeded the balance allowing for about 2 months, and we should therefore I think tell her that her app't. ends with the date of our letter, so informing CA also.
