With reference to Your Lordship's despatch No.265 of 8th April, I have the honour to return herewith the enclosures received from the Foreign Office in original and to inform Your Lordship that the records of the Custodian of Enemy Property show that various personal effects, the property of M.H.Pfizinger, were sold under order of the High Court and realized the sum of Rs.62.72, the whole of which has been paid out in claims and administration expenses.

2. I would add for Your Lordship's information that other assets, sold as the property of the Evangelical Lutheran Mission of Leipzig, from its three branches of Miambani, which appears to have been the station at which M.Pfizinger was resident prior to his internment, Ikuha, and Mulango, were sold and realized Rs.12,874.75, from which sum claims amounting to Rs.1,619/35 have been paid and Rs.11,130/- invested by the Treasurer.

I may mention also that twenty-four boxes, handed by the District Commissioner, Kitui, to the Custodian of Enemy Property as having been taken from the mission stations mentioned above, are housed with the latter officer. These have not been opened as they are believed to contain only books and papers.
