2. I would add for Your Lordship's information that other assets, sold as the property of the Evangelical Lutheran Mission of Leipzig, from its three branches of Mismbani, which appears to have been the station at which M.Pfitzinger was resident prior to his internment, Ikulha, and Mulango, were sold and realized Rs.12,874.75, from which sum claims amounting to Rs.1,619/35 have been paid and Rs.11,130/- invested by the Treasurer.
