- (1) T.D. BUTLER Born 1892. Appointed Post-Dict Journeymen
I.A.P., 27 July 1910. Qualified Schreiter. Confined to posts as follows:
" doing good work in the Northern Frontier District. Shows especially, tact
and a strong sense of discipline" (See Billfield - 1. 1. 17)
" An excellent officer who has continued to perform most gallantly
services in the Northern Frontier District." (Maj. Sir. Downing the 1st)

This officer has lately been appointed acting D.C., Merv,
where he is very highly spoken of by his Permanent Commr.
I have formed a very high opinion of the Author's capabilities.

The Sec. C. & S. Merv recommends Author for promotion
to D.C., having over F.W. Bell but the Secy did not
approve, + oppose the promotion of the latter. The Secy states that
Author has shown exceptional ability.

A.C. KIRK Born 1889 Appointed Post Distt Commr.

SAP 26. 12. 1913 Seconded for Service in Somaliland
9 Sept. 1918 Left Somaliland on leave 5 Apr. 1919.

"Very well regarded in public work in Jeloland."

"Hard working in the Uganda Province which he is very

"Shows competency in administration and is generally promising." (Gov. Belfast 1.1.17)

"A very promising officer with plenty of common sense which has been very valuable to him in the Northern Frontier District." (Actg Sec. Bowring 16.1.18)

"I have nothing to add to my remarks of last year." (Actg Sec. Bowring, 1.1.19)

(2) Yes as regards Castle Smith's vacancy
(See minutes on ⁷⁰ 26/12 - bundle now annexed), and
no doubt also as regards Major Lawrence's - that
is, to be filled from outside.

(3) The despatch to Smallday by 138 of 5 Oct 1910
in file E.A. shows that Mr. Kelly was to remain there
for the duration of the war. I think it might
assume further; and from Sir E. Hall's suggestion
in tel. of 23 June 1919 (No. 16) that he should have 6 mos.
England, that he is to return to S.A.P.

It is not clear whether he was Act D.T. or D.T.
- Smallday. & the usual substitute (No. 11) has
called D.T. He probably so noted.
