I have the Honour to acknowledge the receipt of
your letter and enclosures of the 15th November No. 63191^S/1919
approving of the designs for the one rupee currency notes for
use in the East Africa Protectorate and informing us that the
notes for 10 and 7½ rupees will not be required at present.

2. Messrs. De La Rue & Co. inform us that the cost of
the necessary Printing Plates for the one rupee notes, would
be £50 and the price for printing 8,000,000 notes would be
17/- per 1,000.

3. It is proposed to use unwatermarked paper similar
to that in use for the Ceylon one rupee notes, the cost of
which would be 58/6d. per ream 30 set size.

4. The notes would be numbered from 1 00001 to 1 100,000
and then change the prefix to A.

5. The first delivery of the notes is premised in eight
to ten weeks from the placing of the order.

6. We note that instructions will be given later as
to the date and signature to appear on the notes.

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter and enclosures of the 15th November No. 63191^B/1919 approving of the designs for the one rupee currency notes for use in the East Africa Protectorate and informing us that the notes for 15 and 7½ rupees will not be required at present.

2. Messrs. De la Rue & Co. inform us that the cost of the necessary Printing Plates for the one rupee notes, would be 250 and the price for printing 8,000,000 notes would be 17/- per 1,000.

3. It is proposed to use unwatermarked paper similar to that in use for the Ceylon one rupee notes, the cost of which would be 59/6d. per ream 30 set size.

4. The notes would be numbered from ^A 00001 to ^A 100,000 and then change the prefix to ^A 2.

5. The first delivery of the notes is promised in eight to ten weeks from the placing of the order.

6. We note that instructions will be given later as to the date and signature to appear on the notes.
