We have received information from the British Indian
Association of Indian Community, that the
Legislative Council, in its recent deliberations
has decided to recommend the Government to
take steps to provide for the betterment of
the Indian population in the present public
opinion of the Government of British India
should be to provide for the
welfare of the Indian population.
