I am directed by the Secretary of the Treasury to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Brindle's letter of the 8th instant, 1919, and to forward a copy of a telegram from the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate, dated 27th December 1918, in relation to contributions by the Government of Zanzibar to the cost of the King's African Rifles; and I am to inform you that I agree with the Secretary of State for the Colonies that in the circumstances there can be no question of the Government contributing more than the amount saved on the provision made in the estimates which, it appears from Mr. Brindle's telegram, has already been done in respect of the two periods.

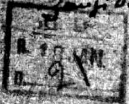
