Sir,

With reference to your letter No. 54765/1918, dated the 3rd December, 1918, enclosing Supplementary Rolls of native ranks of the East Africa Police for operations in 1915, I am commanded by the Army Council to inform you that they have approved of the award of the Africa General Service Medal with clasp "East Africa 1915" to the individuals included on such rolls, and that the decorations in question, consisting of 13 Medals and 13 Clasps, are being despatched to the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate, Nairobi for disposal in accordance with the request contained in your letter. A completed copy of this Medal Roll is sent herewith for retention.

I am to state that the copy of the Medal Roll (East Africa Police) asked for in the 3rd paragraph of your letter was forwarded to you enclosed in War Office letter, No. 68/57/709, dated the 14th June 1918, relating to Captain L. Hanley of the East Africa Police.

Paragraph 4 of your letter, as to the effect of the remark "dismissed" on nominal rolls, has been noted.

I am also to acknowledge receipt of your letter No. 60009/1918, of the 19th ultimo, enclosing further Medal Rolls, containing the names of 9 Officers and 240 (Native) Non-commissioned Officers and men of the 4th King's African Rifles, for operations in 1913 against the Doringa Tribe and in 1914 against the Turkana Tribe. These Rolls are receiving consideration.

I am to draw your attention to the fact that no Medal Rolls have yet been received for the operations against the Morenian Tribe under Army Order 222 of 1916.
