Dear Machtig,

With reference to your note of 15th instant. What we meant by our 75329/54 of 22nd April was that, following our rule that gratuity is not admissible for officers who receive special (as opposed to Pay Warrant) rates of pay, you would not give gratuity to officers who were exceptionally remunerated instead of receiving the ordinary East African military rates. Hayes Sadler appeared to us to be one of these but we were not fully alive to the position as you now state it and I agree that officers of Military Political Department paid at ordinary (East African) military rates may have the gratuity.
