With reference to your letter number 38312/1919 dated 11th June 1919, relative to the recovery of the sum of £63.6s.8d in respect of maintenance in hospital of Dr. W. Lovell. I am directed to acquaint you that this officer was court martialled for drunkenness and dismissed from His Majesty's Service on 2nd May 1918, and he was not entitled to medical treatment in a Military Hospital or to a refund of medical expenses privately incurred after that time.

As his illness was contracted in 1914, this Department cannot therefore accept any responsibility with regard to the expenses incurred by him, and it is considered that the sum of £63.6s.8d should be recovered from Dr. Lovell himself.
