Sir,

I am commanded by the Army Council to acknowledge the receipt of Colonial Office letter dated 2nd September, 1919, No.47707/1919, and to acquaint you in reply that, as desired by Viscount Milner, Mr.N.C.Barrance will be permitted to remain at the Royal Victoria Hospital, Netley, until the necessary arrangements have been made to admit him to a suitable civil institution.

A hospital stoppage of 8s/- (eight shillings) a day will, however, be chargeable in respect of Mr.Barrance's maintenance, &c., while under treatment in the military hospital, and the Council assume that this charge will be met from Colonial Office funds.
