With reference to your letter the 17th January last No 2688/1919 relative to Mr. C.P.G. Jones formerly a Lieutenant in the East African local forces, I am directed to inform you that, had this Officer belonged to the Imperial Forces, he would have been eligible for a renewal of Retired Pay at the rate of £175 - - a year from the 10th January 1919 to the 22nd July 1919.

Shortly before the expiration of the latter date a further Medical Examination would be necessary with a view to determining the question of renewal of Retired Pay.
