In reply to your letter of the 31st instant, 1919, I am directed to acquaint you that Lieutenant F. S. L. Foster, Unattached List, East African Local Forces, has been examined by a medical board, and that the medical authorities of this Department have decided that his disability is not attributable to, but was aggravated by military service, the disablement being assessed at 60 per cent for nine months.

Had he been an officer of the Imperial Forces, he would have been awarded retired pay at £52.10.0 a year from the date of relinquishment until the 10th December, 1919 in the first instance.
