In reply to your letter 1315/1919 dated 14th January last, I am directed to say that had Lieutenant F.S. Joelson, Unattached List, East African Forces, belonged to the Imperial Army, he would have been awarded retired pay at the rate of £87.10.0 a year from the date of his relinquishing his Commission up to the 23rd August next in the first instance. Towards the end of the period he would, on application, be examined by a medical board with a view to the further consideration of his case.
