ROUGH DIARY OF EVENTS IN JUBA LAND

- 1860. Somali invasion began. Bartirri were the first tribe to cross the Juba.
- 1865. Mr. Vanderdecken in S.S. "Ghelph" reached Bardera. Was wrecked and most of his crew killed. Sultan of Zanzibar sent an Arab Garrison, who built Kismayu Port.
- 1871. The Imperial British East African Company took over the administration.
- 1878. The Herti rose - and there occurred at Kismayu the incident, known as Todd's baraza. Gobwen was taken by the Somalis and Hyderabad Contingent which had mutinied. Mr. Hamilton was killed.
- 1885. Kismayu attacked. The Herti were finally beaten and pacified.
- 1895. Goshu was visited and examined.
- July 1895. The Imperial Government took over control from the Imperial British East African Company. Sir A. Hardinge, the Commissioner, visited the Province.
- Nov. 1895. Mr. Craufurd visited Afmadu.
- April 1899. Yonti boma was attacked and captured.
- 1899. Mr. Jenner visited Dugh.
- 1900. At the end of October Mr. Jenner and his escort were murdered west of Afmadu.
- 1900. Ogaden expedition under Col. Ferman with 4 coys. I.A. & Coys. 16 Bombay Infantry. 50 Aden Camel Troops and 2 Mountain guns occupied ~~the~~ and marched to Samassa - where the Somalis attacked them.
- 1900. A post of 125 men established at Ifudu.
- 1904. H. M. Commissioner held a very successful Baraza at
