In reply to your letter of the 14th ultimo, 1919, relative to the case of Mr. [redacted] Lieutenant, East African Transport Corps, I wish to acquaint you that, under the provisions of British Army Regulations, he would have been awarded a year of temporary retirement from the 5th August, 1919, until the 10th September, 1920, at the expiration of which he would again be medically examined with a view to the further consideration of his case.

I am to add that as the medical authorities of this department cannot certify that the effects of the [redacted] will be permanent, no permanent award has been authorized at this date.
